I have enjoyed being able to have some in depth looks at a couple of important Biblical masterpieces these last four weeks. As many of you know I am preaching on the first letter to the Corinthians on Sunday morning. I am finding that this is more than just Paul's correction for a first century church. These passages speak very clearly to the church of the 21st century. People problems have always been a challenge for churches. No group of Christians ever really gets by without some frustrations and challenges as we live and seek to serve together. Paul reminds us that the wisdom we often employ to solve our problems is worldly or natural. We seek solutions based on human wisdom and logic rather than on the wisdom that comes from God. Paul tells us as he told the Corinthians that churches will only function well and Christians will only grow spiritually as we seek spiritual solutions and follow the wisdom that comes from God. I trust these sermons will be as helpful to you as they are to me. God's word speaks to us in ways that can really make a big difference in our lives and our fruitfulness for His Kingdom.

We are also looking verse by verse through the book of Hebrews in our connection class that meets after worship. This is another book with a very important message to us. The old traditions of religion must give way to the message of Christ. I am reminded that the Word of God is just what it says it is; the tool God uses to bring clarity and hope to a broken world. My wish and prayer for all of us in 2018 is to renew our interest in the Bible. Lets study to show ourselves approved, workman that need not to be ashamed, rightly dividing the word of truth. (2 Timothy 2:15) Enjoy your February. Remember to send along a Valentine to someone special in your life. Hey, there are a lot of people in our world that need love.
