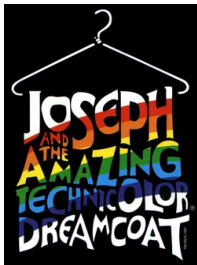
Jayelen Knowles, daughter of John and Jacque Knowles, was awarded the **Valedictorian** for her Senior Class!
