There is a verse that has been a motivation to me and I must admit a source of some guilt. It is Proverbs 11:30 – *“The fruit of the righteous is a tree of life, and those who win souls are wise.”* The verse itself is an example of Hebrew parallelism. The meaning of the first stanza of the verse is amplified in the second using different terminology. This is intended to make the meaning more clear. When a person lives a good or righteous life, there is life-giving fruit that flows from that life. It is similar to what Jesus teaches when He tells us that a good tree brings forth good fruit. A good person bears fruit that many can come and enjoy.

The second stanza extends the meaning. Those that are a positive influence on others are said to be wise. That is, the positive influence affects the winning of their soul. Many people, obviously, have come to know Jesus because of the positive influence of another person. Our lives and how we live them does matter. Our good testimony and positive lifestyles may be used to influence others to Jesus. What is intimidating about this is that when we are a poor example, that probably does damage. When I consider that someone might avoid Jesus because of my failures, that is guilt producing. In reality I know that people miss heaven as a personal choice.

But it still doesn't create a useable excuse to be less than we might be. We all have bad days. The best thing we can do about it is to be mindful to let our lights shine. Allow people to see Jesus even in our brokenness. Jesus is the true Tree of Life. However it happens that we point people to Him is generally a good thing. If we are to be faithful to our calling as believers we must concern ourselves with the lost. The wise person wins souls. We win them with our righteous lifestyles and we win them with our faithful words that lift up Jesus and honor His work. Blessing,

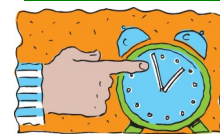
